Walk 8 – North Circular Grade - Strenuous Start point – Village Pub Time – 2 hours Distance – 5.3Km/3.3mls

Walk description – A mixture of farm land and woodland.

- Go down the village past the estate entrance and after 100m take the steep road up the hill directly ahead.
- Just after the bend, on your left (foot path sign), go over the wooden stile and then another wooden stile into a field.
- Keeping the boundary fence/wall on your left walk all the way to the kissing gate and access the road.
- Go over the road and up the track. Ignore the track to house right and bear left to Glyn Uchaf farm.
- When you get to the farm buildings turn left between the stone barn and farmhouse
- Go through the farmyard and up a track bearing right to a gate and go through it onto a track.
- Carry on to the next gate (200m) and go through it.
- Keeping the fence to your left go 300m to another gate and go through it.

- With you back to the gate aim for a point in the woodland boundary at 11 o'clock where there is a small wooden bridge.
- Cross it into the wood.
- Walk as best you can in a straight line for about 150m until you come to a stile that takes you into the next field.
- Walk straight ahead to a gate.

There may be temporary horse fencing in this area but you are ok to cross it using the access points – look for yellow handles in the fencing ribbon.

Before the foot and mouth outbreak in 2001 there was a rare breed farm at Parc Glyn. It was a great attraction with children able to feed the weird and wonderful animals Unfortunately it was unable to continue after the outbreak.

- Now go to and through another gate and keeping the low wall to your left head for the bottom left corner of the field and a kissing gate which takes you into woodland. The obvious path now drops down to the road.
Careful here as you access and cross the road.
- Go straight across the road to a lane and after 100m turn left at the red post box.

- Follow the lane for about 600m.
- At a sharp left bend (sign for Tyddyn Mawr holiday cottages) take the lane bearing right up a fairly steep hill towards more woodland.
- After about 200m the surfaced road runs out just after the scout camp. Enter the woodland through the gate on your right.
- Go 20m and turn left onto a path.
- Walk for about 300m until you see a cottage on your left.
- Carry on a bit and then go over the stile on your left.
- Cross the small stone bridge over a stream and then a black fence into the field.
- Keep the wall to your left and when you come to a wooden gate go through it into the next field.
- Go diagonally left down a very vague grass path to the stile. This stile has 13 steps and is quite high so be careful descending to the track.
- Go left till you get to a road. Turn right and walk to a T-junction (500m).
- Turn left and then at the next junction turn left again and back down the village to the start point at the village shop.
